Letter for presumptive COVID-19 exposure of a student

Parents and Staff,

Brownsville I.S.D. has been notified that a student who attends _____ (campus) has had direct exposure to an individual who recently tested positive for COVID-19. The _____ (campus) student is currently self-quarantining at home, is not displaying any symptoms of the virus and has not tested positive for the virus.

_____ (campus) has been deeply sanitized and although schools and offices have been closed since _____ (closure date) and remain closed at this time, all Brownsville I.S.D. employees and students are instructed to continue to follow CDC guidelines and recommendations and to practice social distancing.
